Engine Types

Option 1) – GM Sealed 602 Crate. Engine must be sealed by GM (or a recognized pre-approved racing series) or a Pre-Approved GM certified engine or series builder/rebuilder.

Option 2) – Unsealed GM 602 Crate. Engine must be built by GM sealed motor specifications, specifications required, (including all legal internal engine part numbers) can be found in **Lake View Motor Speedway Unsealed Crate Engine Rulebook.**

Option 3) – Budget 350/2BBL- Engine must be built to Lake View Motor Speedway budget engine specifications required, (including all legal internal engine part numbers) can be found in **Lake View Motor Speedway Budget Engine Rule Book 2024.**

LVMS IMCA Modifieds Optional Wheels, Tires, Weight Rules

Option 1) 8" Inch Wheels – Any tires, Siping/grooving ok. No chemical.

Option 2) 13" or 14" Inch Wheels- Any tires on Left Front, Right Front, Left Rear.

Right Rear MUST have Hoosier D300, or D400 as right rear option.

No siping or grooving. No chemical. (light grinding ok).

Weight: 2400lbs minimum with driver.

Final Rule Notes

Any rules not covered by this rulebook, refer to Mid -East Modified rulebook for clarification and enforcement. Any engine rules (sealed crate) refer to Mid-East Modified rulebook OR Lake View Motor Speedway (unsealed or budget engine) rulebook. Any rules that fall into a grey area, or that conflict, Lake View Motor Speedway track officials (management and tech officials) will determine clarification, enforcement, and any penalties applied, at their discretion.
